*Media may pick up credentials* at the designated entrance on Church Street on the south side of Summit Arena on the following dates and times (local time is Central Time): March 21 from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., March 22 from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., March 23 from noon to 9:30 p.m., March 24 from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. and March 25 from 3 to 5 p.m. Photo ID will be required to obtain credentials. Credential pickup for others not permitted. Each credential may be used only by the individual to whom it is issued. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in ejection from Summit Arena and loss of credential privileges for the remainder of the championship. All bags are subject to search.

*Media parking* will be provided free of charge for the duration of the tournament in a designated lot located on the south side of Summit Arena.
